Operation Seed to Harvest is a Christ-focused program committed to teaching young people through the beauty of a garden. We believe that the garden holds many lessons for children of all ages and through a carefully designed curriculum, our leaders will guide groups of students through lessons in gardening, business and walking with God.

Instruction Model

At Operation Seed to Harvest, **second through fourth grade students** will participate in a variety of activities in small teams. The activities include getting into the garden, planting, finding bugs, harvesting, preparing food, exploring various forms of art, playing games, learning about business and diving deeper into the Word of God. These 90-minute lessons once a week will cover a curriculum centered around: Environment, Nutrition, Community Spirit, Social Skills, Self-Confidence, Leadership Skills, Volunteerism, Motor Skills and Spiritual Context in Christ.

All of our students will work in collaboration with team mentors (**ninth through eleventh grade students**). Our mentors are committed, passionate young people who are eager to share their experiences and walk in learning with the students. Two to three **adult Garden, Spiritual and Business leaders** will be present to lead the groups of students and mentors through the lesson and activities of the day.
